GALVESTON, TX — With great sadness I announce LCDR/USN/Ret Roy "Bubba" L. Segars II went to be with the Lord on March 28, 2023.

Roy graduated from La Marque High School in 1960, and Texas Tech in 1966, with a chemistry degree. He then joined the U.S. Navy, serving from 1966 to 1986 as a Navy pilot. In Viet Nam Roy was shot down on Oct. 29, 1971. He received many service commendations, among them the Distinguished Service Metal, the Navy Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star and the Purple Heart. After he left the Navy, Roy flew as a captain for Continental Airlines until he retired at the age of 60. He was then hired as a Lead Pilot for the Saudi Arabian Royal Family for 3 years. Roy left his wife Patty "Dee" Segars, two daughters and their husbands,
