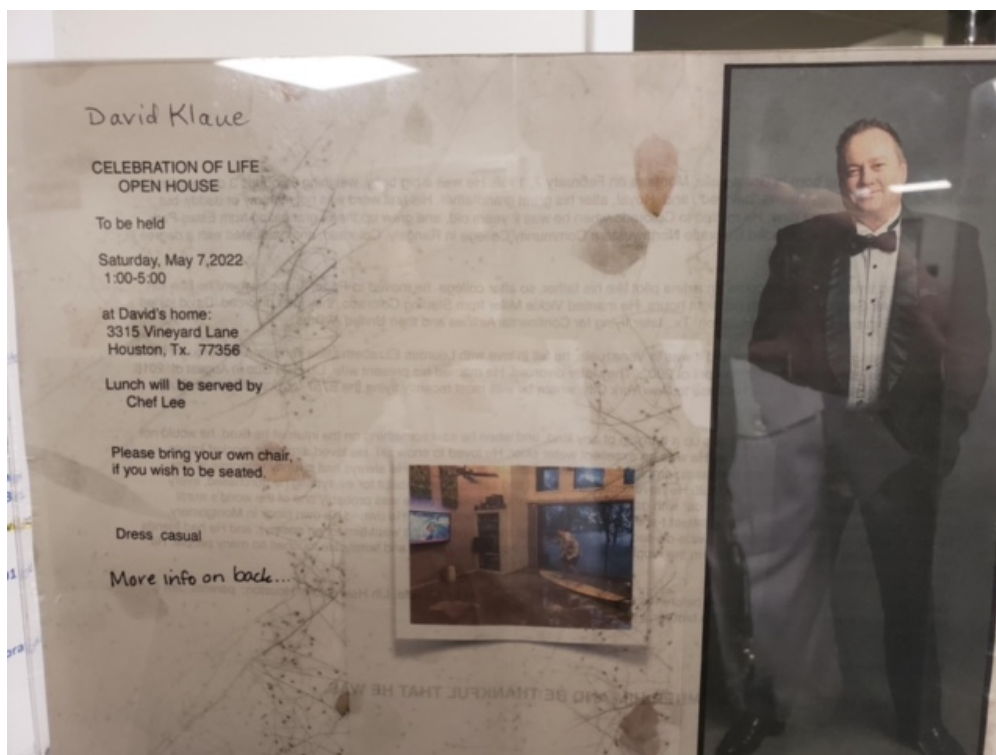

They later divorced. He married his present wife, Lih Hsin Guo in August of 2018. His bid with Continental changed his base to New York City, where he was most recently flying the B757 for United Airlines, But he always came home to Houston.

He never opened his mail and saved every receipt for everything he purchased, every meal he ate and every time he filled his car with gas. He loved fast cars and old cars.
