Captain Curtis Landry
March 7, 1959 - February 10, 2023

Curtis Landry, local Vail resident, passed away peacefully last February in California with his daughter Luci at his side. Curtis attended the Culver Military Academy in Indiana, 1975-77, the Air Force Academy,1977-78, and graduated from Metro State University, Denver, 1981.

Once he completed all his FAA pilot certificates, Curtis joined the Wyoming Air National Guard stationed in Cheyenne. After Air Force pilot training at Williams AFB in Arizona on the Lockheed C-130, he attained the rank of Captain.

While flying for the Guard Curtis was hired by Continental Airlines at the age of 26, based in Denver and living in Vail. He flew both domestic and international flights on the B-727, B-757, B-747 and finally as Captain on the B-737.

Curtis is survived by his only daughter, Luci, the true love of his life. Luci was a student at Purdue University in their professional pilot program.
