



Word was just received from Golden Eagles member Don Griffin that Golden Eagles member Bill Twyman was hospitalized this evening as a result of a severe seizure and loss of consciousness. I spoke with Bill's wife Carol this evening and she has family with her. She said he experienced a Ventricular Fibrillation (V-fib), not a heart attack, and that he suffered a severe episode of oxygen deprivation on the way to the hospital. She asked that our members keep her, Bill and their family in their prayers. Of course all of us Golden Eagles pray that Bill has a complete recovery. Carol has asked that we refrain from making any calls to her until this crisis with Bill is resolved.

We will provide additional information as it is received.

The email received from Don Griffin after he spoke with Bill's wife earlier is posted below. Thanks to Don for providing this unfortunate news.

Here is what Carol said. Bill is stable but not responding to anything right now. He had a cardiac arrest, not a heart attack. It was a ventricular fibrillation and he is comatose now. Both his heart rate and blood pressure fell. 911 was called but the ride from his home to the hospital was a 30 minute ride and his brain got no oxygen. The doctor said his vital signs are good, heart is not the problem, the brain is the problem. The earliest anything will be known will be Thursday.
