Captain Jim McBride (UAL retired), father of First Officer Sean McBride, A320 Flight Instructor. Jim joined UAL in 1985. During his 17 year career at United, Jim served as a 747-100 Second Officer, 747-100 First Officer and Training Check Airman, 737-200 Captain, A320 Standards Captain and LCA and 727 Second Officer Check Airman. Jim retired from UAL in 2002 and flew the Colorado Rockies baseball team as a 727 Captain for 12 years.

Prior to his career at United, Jim flew the F-4D Skyray and F-4 Phantom in the U.S. Marine Corps and also flew the F-101 Voodoo as an exchange pilot with the U.S. Air Force. He was a veteran of more than 100 missions in Vietnam. He left the military in 1968 and joined Continental Airlines where he served until 1983. Jim was a truly gifted and professional aviator, proud ALPA member, great friend and mentor to many. He was also a cherished Husband, Father, Grandfather and Great Grandfather.

Funeral services will take place on Friday February 7th at 10:30 AM Mountain time at Green Mountain Presbyterian Church, 12900 W. Alameda Pkwy, Lakewood, CO 80228. Reception will follow at Fort Logan National Cemetery at 3:00 PM. Current United Airlines pilots are encouraged to wear their uniforms.
