In 1969, Randy began flying as a 1st Officer, based in Dallas, for Texas International Airliners. He retired from CO in 2005 while based in Houston. At retirement, Capt. Randy Rawls was flying our Boeing 777s to Paris, London and Tokyo.

His wife, Susan Rawls, also retired from CO in 2005 while an International F/A based in Houston.
