A friend of 57-years died yesterday morning. Captain Emily Howell-Warner, of Frontier, CAL and the FAA, was acquainted with a lot of us old CAL guys so I thought I should tell you so you can announce it. She was the first female airline transport Captain in American history and her uniform hangs in the Smithsonian.

I have no details on services or internment.

She could fly the box the airplane came in, was always a loyal friend from the good times, and a

great gal to be around. Smooth air on your flight west, Emily, you were exceptional.
