



The sad news that retired Continental Captain Eric Hodges has flown west has been provided by Golden Eagles members Captain Jim Tucker and Captain KD Jost. Once again the available information is very limited and additional information will be provided when it becomes available.

According to the limited information available, Captain Hodges, his wife Tandi, who is a 787 FO with United, and his son were flying to the Dallas area in a Cessna 310. The aircraft crashed near Dallas due to unknown reasons and Eric was killed, but his wife Tandi and his son survived with injuries of an unknown nature. They are in hospitals in Dallas.

The Golden Eagles sends condolences to Captain Hodges family for the tragic loss of Eric and the injuries to his wife and son; and we send our sincere wishes to First Officer Tandi Hodges and her son for a speedy and complete recovery.
