Our lives are the date of our birth and the date of our death, with a dash in between. The dash stands for all that we did, all that we were in our lifetime. Will's number on the right side of the dash is November 3, 2022. He died tonight at 8:34 pm here at home with Aimee, Seth and me hugging him, talking to him, crying our hearts out when we knew he had gone. Rose and Saul had come over a short while before to say their goodbyes to Papa. This has been such a painful and

difficult journey. Will died peacefully and pain free; now he can fly free of these earthly bonds. Thank you to all of you who have read these journals and sent prayers, love, cards, gifts and meals. Been her to help, to cry to laugh, and all of those who attended Will's last hurrah on July 30th when we celebrated his retirement from United Airlines and his 65th birthday.
