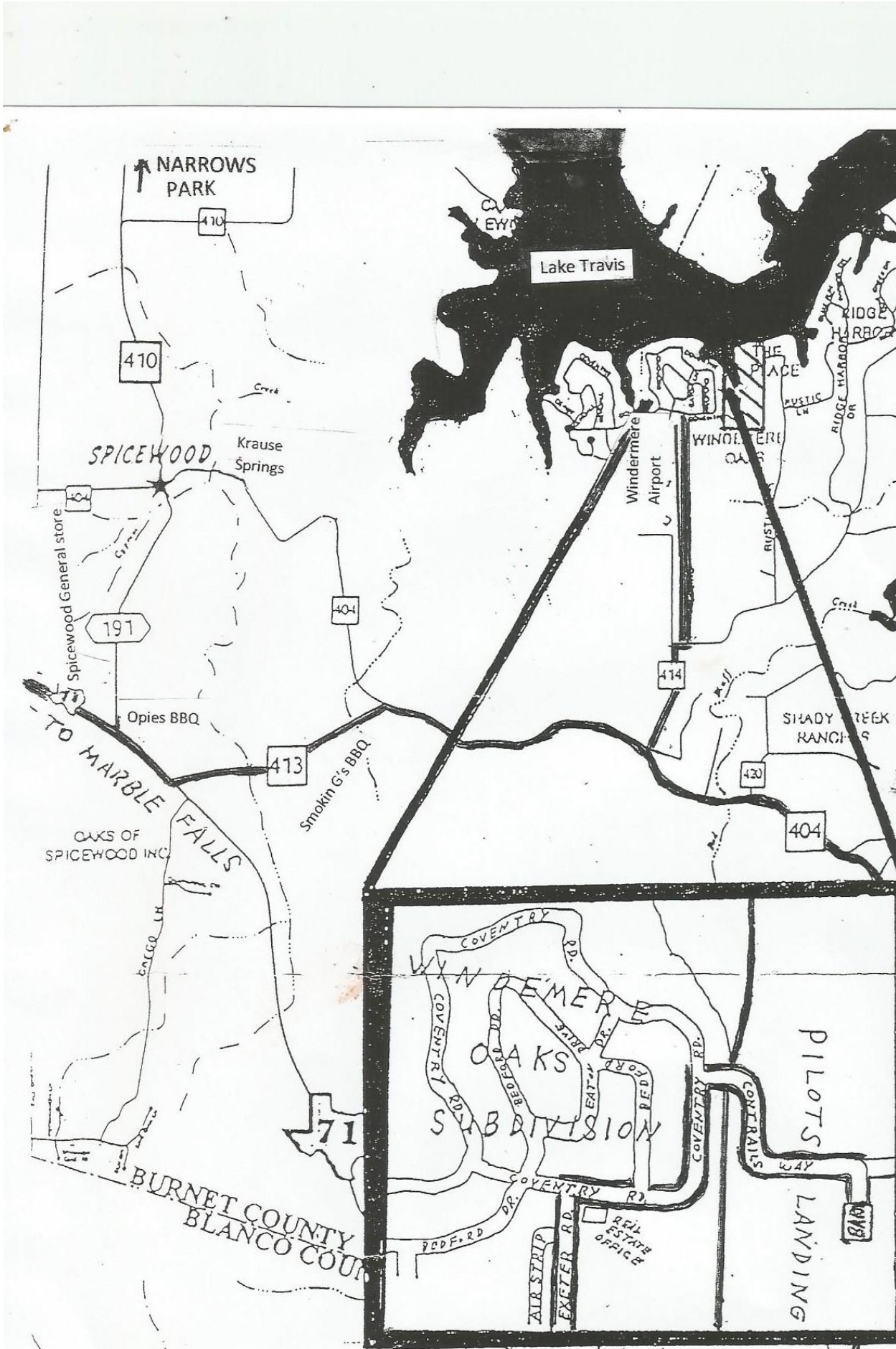
As depicted on the map below, the access roads to Ray's are off of **Hwy 71** that runs between Austin and Hyw 281. **If coming from the west from Hwy 281**, turn left on local road **413**, bear right on **404**, left on **414** to airport entrance and gate. **If coming from Austin** turn right onto **404 (Paleface Ranch Road)**, then turn right on **414** to airport entrance and gate. **WHEN REACHING THE AIRPORT BOUNDARY ON 414, YOU WILL TURN RIGHT FOR ABOUT 100 YARDS AND THEN MAKE A LEFT TO THE ENTRANCE GATE AT EXETER ROAD FOR THE AIRPORT AND WINDERMERE OAKS COMMUNITY. (ADDED)**

Once you have passed the first gate (**code 3966**) to the airport community, proceed down **Exeter road** past the runway and turn right at the "T" intersection on to **Coventry Rd**. Proceed around the curve to the left and you will see the entrance to "**Pilot's Landing**" at **Contrails Way** on the right. The entrance code if the gate is closed (should be open) is "**key symbol 008727**". Proceed on private road about 200 yards to the entrance to the barn "**Pilot's Pub**" on the right. You can park on the grass to the left of the concrete pad in front of the barn or wherever there is an open space.

Thanks again to Ray and Mary Booth for offering their place for our luncheon. This should be a fun gathering and I hope all our members can attend. As you know, we canceled the July lunch due to summer travels and the heat, so it's time to catch up on some lies and jokes. I will send out a list of those attending when I get the totals so that you can arrange car pooling as desired. See you there, and bring a guest (potential member) if you can.
